





# **Industry Presentations Guidelines**

This document contains guidelines for Industry Presentation organisers, within IEEE ICC 2020.

#### Goal

An Industry Presentation, to be held in a conference time-slot, aims at giving an organization the possibility to present a topic of interest to conference participants.

#### **Proposal**

The proposal for an Industry Presentation should follow the **template** indicating the following information:

- Proposer information.
- Title, Motivation, and Background.
- Structure and Content.
- Key Bibliography and Level/Pre-Requisites for attendees.

The proposal should be sent:

- to the Industry Presentations Co-chairs, Rashid Mijumbi and Albena Mihovska, at icc2020.ind.presentations@gmail.com,
- as a PDF attachment,
- as a file named "Presenrartion-Proposal proposer(s)name(s)",
- by the deadline, 14th February 2020.

## Structure

To allow a successful Presentation, the following structure should be followed:

- The Industry Presentation occupies a conference time-slot, i.e., 1h30.
- Industry Presentations will be held during the conference main programme, in parallel to other technical sessions.
- The Industry Presentation should be composed of a presentation, and it may include demos, show of equipment, or any other means found relevant.

# **Public information**

The following information will be made public:

- Industry Presentation's Title.
- Title, Motivation, and Background.
- Structure and Content.
- Key Bibliography and Level/Pre-Requisites.







• Presenter's name, position in company/institution, company/institution, country, CV, photo.

### **Evaluation**

The following criteria will be taken into consideration for the evaluation and ranking of Industry Presntation proposals:

- Relevance.
- Timeliness.
- Relationship to Patrons.
- Relationship to Exhibitors.

The Industry Forum and Exhibition and the Industry Program Chairs will conduct the evaluation.

## Registration

The following apply to Industry Presentation Speakers:

- If attendance is only for the day of the presentation, they get a free One Day Registration each.
- If attendance is for more than the day of the presentation, each will have to pay for a regular registration.
